<u>Seminar Summary:</u> In the management of a school environment, Federal, State and Local Police, along with School Personnel require education and research based solutions along with training to address school safety issues. Targeted school violence and bullying are eliciting an ever-increasing concern among law enforcement and school officials, as well as parents, guardians and students.

Lt. Col. Dave Grossman is an internationally recognized scholar, author, soldier, and speaker who is one of the world's foremost experts in the field of human aggression and the roots of violence and violent crime. He is a member of the American Board for Certification in Homeland Security, and the American College of Forensic Examiners Institute. He has trained educators and law enforcement professionals in the field of school safety, making presentations at the state and regional level, in all 50 states and over a dozen foreign nations.

Col. Grossman is a former West Point psychology professor, Professor of Military Science, and an Army Ranger who has combined his experiences to become the founder of a new field of scientific endeavor, which has been termed "killology."
