Purpose of the Grant Program	<b>The purpose of this grant program is to implement programs related to UWBECC's platforms of Education, Health and Wellness, and Financial Stability. Programs providing services that focus on early childhood and young children (birth to 8 years) will be prioritized.</b>
Project Period	<b>2 years, starting 7/1/16</b>
Available Funding	<b>The minimum annual request is \$20,000. There is no upper limit. Most applicants apply for 15-25% of their program budgets.</b>
Program Deliverables	<b>Programs that align to the focus areas and meet community goals. Each platform has several goals and performance measures, which can be found in the RFP.</b>
Evaluation Requirements	<b>Grantees must use collect data and secure program participant feedback, and use evaluation data to improve their programs. Preference is for standardized tools and higher-order evaluation (experimental design, quasi-experimental design) where appropriate.</b>
Other Pertinent Info	<b>Will not fund capital expenditures or direct payments, such as scholarships. Will not fund pilot, demonstration, or start-up programs. Programs must have existed for at least 2 years. Applicants must provide up to 3 years of program performance data.</b>
